Patient Guidelines for Prescribed and Over-the-Counter Medications

Aspirin and anti-inflammatory compounds are very strong anticoagulants which can cause bleeding problems in normal individuals. Therefore, all patients must stop taking all sources of aspirin and/or anti-inflammatory medications for seven (7) days prior to your procedure.

*Another common, but potent anticoagulant is COUMADIN. DO NOT stop taking COUMADIN, XARELTO, PLAVIX or ELIQUIS prior to your procedure before consulting your doctor. The time frame to stop taking these medications prior to your procedure varies for each patient.
